

# What is the Northland Sport Fund?

- In 2016, Sport Northland and the Northland Community Foundation (NCF) established the Northland Sport Fund.
- Since the establishment of the Northland Sport Fund, NCF and Sport Northland have been instrumental in growing the fund to the current level of \$237,840.
- The distributions of the Kauri Club Fund (a fund under the umbrella of the Northland Sports Fund) has supported the operation of the Educare Northland Sports Talent Hub, which provides talent development services, grants and scholarships to promising young Northland sports people to better prepare them to reach the top of their chosen sports.
- Both Sport Northland and NCF encourage all Northlanders who love active recreation and sport to consider leaving a gift or bequest to the Northland Sport Fund. You can donate your funds, or leave a gift through your Will (bequest), directly to the Kauri Club Fund for the benefit of talented young Northland athletes, or you can create your own 'named fund' under the Northland Sports Fund umbrella, and leave the donation/ bequest to your own personal nominated sport or active recreation cause.
